The New Year is starting in a few months and we need to end this year on a high, so let's continue to work hard and succeed making this a great year.

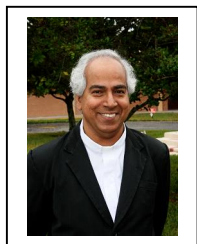

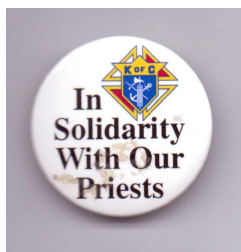
Please recall what we learnt in the catechism: *"God made me to know him, to love him, and to serve him in this world, and to be happy with him forever in the next."*
