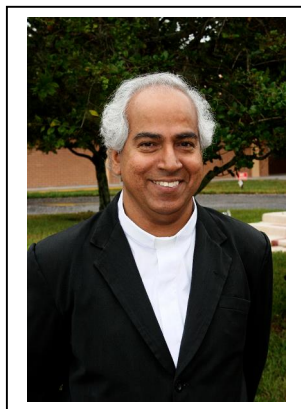
Pro-life
