MARK S BLANTON Only Having Insurance "Through Work" Doesn't Work



Do you know anyone whose life or career has drastically changed during these years of economic downturn? It is very likely that someone in your immediate or extended family or group of friends is facing financial uncertainty. Maybe there is a possibility that you (or your spouse) could lose your job or change employers.
