West Pasco Pregnancy Center saves Lives

In 2008 there were 635 abortion minded women that visited WPPC. In 2009 there were 1,450 abortion minded women that visited WPPC. In 2010 there were 1,800 abortion minded women that visited WPPC.

In 2011, 2012 and 2013 I do not have any information at this time. However, I am sure that each year the number of abortion minded women increase if you look at statistics above.



In each of these years (2008,2009,2010) 90 percent of the abortion minded women changed their minds and carried their babies to full term, especially after seeing their babies on the ultra-sound machine. West Pasco Pregnancy Center has now purchased a new ultra-sound machine which shows the babies in 3D and color.
