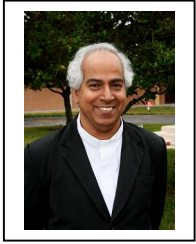

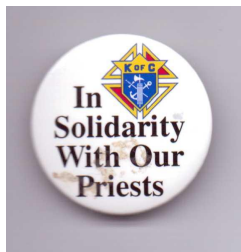
Let us keep this great day of "deliverance" close to our heart. Let us cherish the belief that our God has become one among us to show us the path of salvation.
