Grand Knights Message by Joseph L. Tengowski My Brothers:


This will be my LAST MESSAGE as your Grand Knight.

Chaplain's Message

HAIL MARY FULL OF GRACE



Dear Brother Knights,

This month of May, I would like to share with you some of my reflections on Our Blessed Mother Maryøs life.

Her story goes like this: Mary was a simple village girl. She was very ordinary just like you and me. But she became the favorite one of God, the one full of Grace@ One day God asked her to become His mother. Though Mary was confused and amazed at God@s request, she believed her God and said yes to Him. Mary@s -yes@ the great of Fiato, changed the course of human history. A simple girl@s "YES" could change the whole world.(Our -yes@ or -no@is

very powerful. It can either build up or destroy a community or a family.)

Let Maryøs life inspire us to believe in her Son, Jesus. If we believe in Jesus and live our faith, we can bring changes in this world. Our faith can transform our Nation, our parish community, our family, our children, our grand ones or whoever comes to our lives. But this transformation has to sprout first in you and me. To begin with, change some of our harsh attitudes. Surrender to the will of God and become His favorite ones. Once we are filled with Godøs Grace, we would become the source of peace to all who come to us. We not only experience peace in ourselves but also experience it in our surroundings. Graceful and peaceful ones are Godøs favorite. Something is wrong somewhere in us if we canøt come closer to God or to our brothers and sisters.

Let us take to our hearts two greetings: the one greeted by the Angel, õHail Mary, full of Grace.ö and the other by St Elizabeth, õBlessed is she who has believedö (LK1, 45.).

These two greetings summarized the life of that simple village girl who became the Mother and :discipleø of Jesus. She is Blessed and full of Grace.

Take a moment to reflect on our discipleship. What is that summarizes yours and my life? How do others often greet us? How do others describe us?

Our vocation is not different from that of Mary. It is a call to become blessed: a blessed mother or a father, a blessed sister or a brother. If we win these greetings, we win our Community. When you say the Hail Mary, feel for a moment, that you are the favorite child of God and that the Lord is with you and within youø Donøt say the typesø to ourselves; say tyesø to Godøs will. Now, please say õHail Mary, Full of Graceí and a great õAmen. Ö Your the Amenø summarizes your life.
