Pray to end Abortion!!

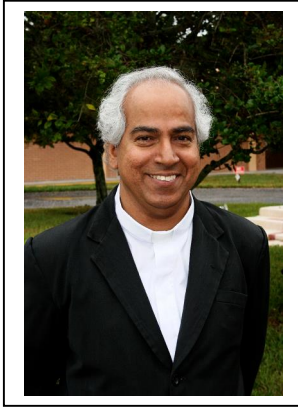

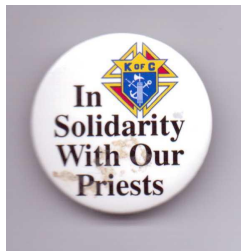
Let us focus on Christ. Know more about Him and listen to Him. Learn how to inherit life eternal. Forget the little worries of everyday life. Just focus on God and move on.

Don't Assume You Can't Afford Disability Income Insurance
