Grand Knight Message



My brother Knights the Knights of Columbus is built on four principals Charity, Unity, Fraternity and Patriotism. We are given lessons in these in each degrees. We must live by these as Knights and keep them in mind as we move thru our council business. There have been some early challenges to overcome, but as always this council has stepped up and worked past them to be a success. We are working to make the Save a Life dinner a success in October, so let all work to sell tickets and get donations of baskets and other items to raffle during the evening. If you have contacts that can

donate money to help defer the cost of the dinner. Ask them to donate and they will be recognized during the night. Last month we sponsored the movie night. I feel this is a great start in uniting the Knights and our parish. Again when you are approached to join a project or team take on the task which will make our council stronger. If you donq understand the project or what you have to do, then ask. The only dumb question is the one that is not asked!

Membership is the lifeblood of our council and order. We have a goal of 13 new members and 5 new insurance members. We will be working to thin our rolls by 10 members who have not paid their dues in quite some time. To be a success we will need to bring in 2 new members for each one we suspend. So letter shoot for 26 new members and 10 new insurance members, but remember the 1st degree. We need good Catholic men to join. Not everyone is a candidate for membership just because he is breathing, be proactive but be choosey. To get new members just ask the most common question, as to why it took so long to become member and the answer will be, they were never asked!!

I always listen to what a member has to say, say to them in private, not on the floor disrupting the meeting or undermining the leadership of this council. In the First degree you pledge obedience to the officers of your council and the order. I believe 99% Loyalty is 100% disloyalty, so in the name of Christian brotherhood lets practice Fraternity and Unity, two of the 4 principals of the order. Keep in mind there is a chain of command that needs to be observed in the Knights as in the military. This is needed to make getting our work accomplished in an orderly manner. The first step is to contact your Advocate, if he cannot answer your question then the Grand Knight, if he does not give you the answer you need then go to the District Deputy, then go to the Regional Director, if this is not successful, you contact the State Advocate, then if this is not successful and only then do you go to Supreme. Solving a problem at the lowest level is always the preferred procedure. Remember the answer you may receive may not be the one you want, so if the first and second answer is the same then the remainder of the levels will be giving you the same answer, you may not like it but that is the way the world is. !

Now the Knights of Columbus has grown to 1.8 million members with charity as the organization's primary mission. During the past year, Knights donated more than \$170 million and more than 70.5 million hours of service to charitable causes.

The theme of this year's Convention was drawn from the message of our Holy Father for the World Day of Peace this year: "You will all be brothers: our vocation to fraternity." I quote the Supreme Knight's concluding words at his annual report: "Let us continue our dedication to our principles of charity, unity, fraternity and patriotism with that quiet strength and determination for which we have become known, so that by our example and through our service the world may better know the truth spoken by Pope France—that fraternity is truly the foundation and pathway to peace."

It was an inspiring session. As Knights of Columbus chaplains and at the same time pastors of parishes we face challenges in our ministry to maintain a healthy balance. I had many opportunities to discuss various issues with the Supreme Knight and Supreme Chaplain to know better their visions.
