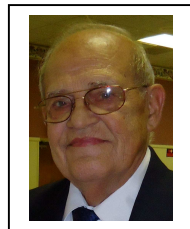
## Grand Knight's Message

Monday, April 29, 2013, 3rd Degree Officers Meeting at 7:30 pm in the Parish Hall.

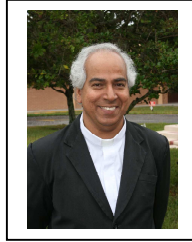

To be honest, more than Church and Liturgy, my mother's cooking fascinated me: especially after fifty days (we have fifty days) of abstinence and fasting. As I grew up my image of Easter changed. My heart and mind slowly shifted from my mother's kitchen to Church and then from there to the person, Jesus Christ. He was crushing and molding me to become someone whom I wavered to become. The more I know Jesus the less I become who I am.

His historical resurrection from the dead puzzled me for a while. I had questions, just like anyone else had. How could someone draw life out of death? There is only one empty tomb in the whole world and that is His. All other tombs are filled with bones and skulls.

Apostles saw Him dying. They wrapped Him in linen and laid Him in a tomb and sealed it with a heavy stone. And all on a sudden He was there with them, eating and drinking and breaking the bread. They saw the nail marks. They touched them. They saw Jesus walking out of death.
