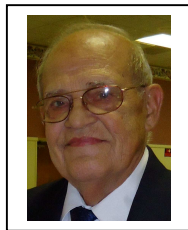

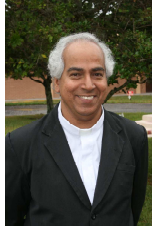


Chaplain's Message

The Knights of Columbus received its fifth invitation to participate in the parade. The State Master along with the Vice Supreme Master would like to invite all the Assemblies to join them in this parade. Please ask the members of your assembly to join our State and Provincial leaders in honoring our war heroes, what better way to express our appreciation for their heroic deeds. One, two or all members will be appreciated.

The Parade will consist of The Color Guard followed by the State and Vice Supreme Master in a convertible in their Light Blue and Gold Chapeau and Capes . The Vice District Marshal in his Green Chapeau and Cape will lead the Color Corps in Purple, White and Red Chapeau's and Cape's.

Our State Photographer, Randy Hale will take pictures, which will appear on the state web site. T.V Channel 8 and 13 will attend. There are fifty units in the parade. The parade route is 8/10 of a mile. There will be a ceremony and a picnic after the parade.
