Chaplain's Message

Each time I write this column I exhort you "TO PRAY!" In my report to you at most every meeting (on the First Thursday) I strongly urge you (verbally) to assist at daily Mass. At most three of you, brother Knights, are at daily Mass here at Our Lady Queen of Peace -- one with his spouse, one alone because he is widowed, and one alone because his wife

is not in the U.S.A.

When I write you encouraging you to pray, I have the idea that by your daily Mass you are making the ideal prayer (by uniting yourself with Jesus and receiving His Body and Blood). Maybe a few words on the daily liturgies (after Eucharist), your prayer, your Mass, will take on more meaning and bring you more love and strength to building up the Kingdom.

During Advent (time before Christmas) we prepared for Christ's Coming in Glory by slowing down through quiet and reflection. At Christmas we celebrated the human birthday of Jesus, our King-God and brother. On Saturday, January 1, we celebrate the Eighth Day of Christmas: The Blessed Virgin Mary, the **Mother of GOD**. This year (2011) this great feast is **not** a holy day of obligation.

On Sunday, January 2, the Epiphany (Manifestation) of the Lord Jesus, we "the nations" (gentiles) have been called to hear the "Good News" and through the Magi worship the long-awaited Lord and King with the gift of our lives.

On Monday, January 3, the Most Holy Name of Jesus ("Yahweh is Salvation") and pay Him homage as Savior by the power of His Holy Name.

On Tuesday, January 4, the holy nun Elizabeth Ann Seton, the first native-born American citizen, was canonized in 1975. She founded the first congregation for women religious (the Sisters of Charity) in the U.S.A.

On Wednesday, January 5, Bishop John Neumann, a very holy and learned man, promoted parochial schools. He was the first American Bishop, canonized in 1977.

On Thursday, January 6, Brother Andre, ("Miracle Man of Montreal"), was a great healer. Over one million people paid their respects at his death at the Oratory of St. Joseph.

On Sunday, January 9, we celebrate the Solemnity, The Baptism of the Lord; Jesus is the "Beloved Son" of the Father, the Light of the Nations and the Lord of all Creation. After this feast we begin **Ordinary Time**. This begins, Monday, January 10, and continues through Tuesday, March 8, the day before Ash Wednesday.

By your attending these Masses, and those following, you will be instructed on the various mysteries of our faith and the lives of those who lived it to the full. You will be inspired by their following of Christ, making His Kingdom happen. You will benefit by their intercession and more readily advance in the Kingdom.
