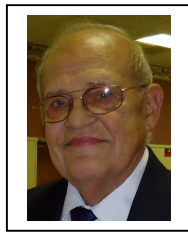

Chaplain's Message



Dear Brother Knights,

Year of Faith October 11, 2012 –
November 24, 2013

Pope Benedict XVI has called a year of Faith, which begins on October 11, 2012. It is the 50th anniversary of the opening of the Second Vatican Council and the 20th anniversary of the Catechism of the Catholic Church. The year of Faith ends on November 24th, 2013, the feast of Christ the King. This should be a time for us to learn more about the spiritual richness of our Catholic faith.



The Knights are the guardians and defenders of Faith. You know that the Order has been called “the strong right arm of the Church”. If it is true we shall not simply exist as Christians but should live as Christians. Accept the call to be the agents of this new evangelization.

First of all what we have to do is: meditate on the “Creed” that we have professed at our Baptism. It tells us what we believe as Catholics. It enables us to live a grace filled life.

“I believe in one God...” I also believe that the Curiosity Rover mission has found evidence of a stream on Mars. These two are entirely different beliefs. Rover’s finding doesn’t affect me personally. It is a fact that simply remains in thinking: only an intellectual exercise.

When my doctor says, ‘exercise will make me healthy’ better believe it and do it daily. An intellectual understanding about a healthy life will not make me a healthy person. I have to find time to put that belief into action. Otherwise I will be sick and ailing.

The ‘Creed’ that we profess is not an intellectual fact but a belief that we have put into action.

Our belief should make difference in us. We should live in such a way that as St. Paul says, ‘it is no longer I, but Christ lives in me’ (Gal2, 20).
