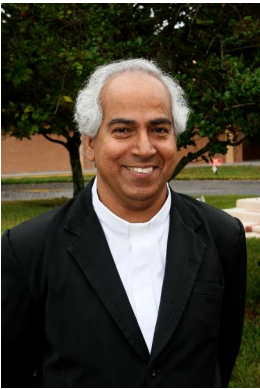

(Excerpts from my regular column for January 1st 2017.)

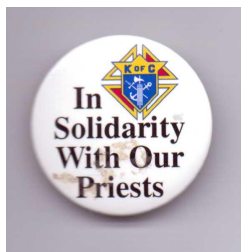

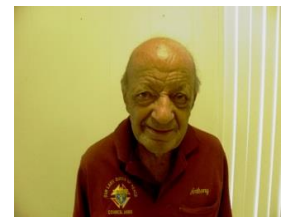

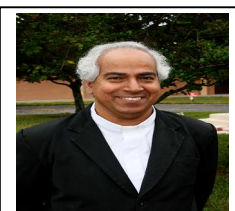
